

## Other Nike Missile Sites in Washington

Each of the former Nike sites surrounding Fairchild AFB have been recorded in the Washington DAHP database. Of the six additional sites, three are launch sites and three are radar sites. These sites, like the Four Lakes Communication Site, were constructed separately and worked in tandem; each launch site has a corresponding radar site. The other Nike sites, however, were not sold in pairs. Each site was individually sold and reused. A short description of each site and the current reuse follows.

<b>Nike Site #</b>	<b>Nike Site (Site Type)</b>	<b>Current Use</b>
F-07	Newkirk Road (Radar Site)	U.S. Army Corps of Engineers – military reuse.
F-07	Craig Road (Launch Site)	Team Challenge – used as a home for wayward boys. Buildings have been modeled to accommodate dormitory-style living.
F-45	Booth Hill (Radar Site)	Privately owned – used as a residence and vehicle restoration shop.
F-45	Medical Lake (Launch Site)	Vacant – no reuse apparent
F-87	McDowell Hill (Radar Site)	Privately owned – used as a residence and emu farm, currently vacant.
F-87	Deep Creek (Launch Site)	Owned by confidential medical records firm – buildings have been converted into offices and warehouse buildings.
